PREPARE AND PROTECT YOUR HOME

You may be asked to clear the work areas by removing curtains, blinds, and nearby furniture. To further protect your home, the installation team will cover floors and nearby furniture with protective materials.

ENSURE A SEAMLESS INSTALLATION

The team will remove old windows and prepare the openings according to the chosen installation method. Once the new windows are inserted, secured, and fastened, your installation expert will apply the required insulation and flashing. Finally, any necessary trim, casing, and hardware will be added for a finished look.

REMOVE AND DISPOSE OF YOUR OLD WINDOWS

Infinity partners will handle the removal and disposal of old windows and patio doors. Following local regulations for materials like glass, metal, and wood ensures an environmentally responsible process.

PERFORM A FINAL WALK-THROUGH

Once installation is complete and work areas are clean, your consultant will typically perform a final walk-through. They will ensure everything is correctly finished, demonstrate the operation and maintenance of particular products, and address any outstanding questions.

Even more durable than tempered glass, laminated glass is often referred to as impact resistant or safety glass due to its vinyl interlayer that tends to remain in place when cracked.

CALIFORNIA FIRE GLASS

Available on windows where forest fire codes require one pane to be made from tempered glass.¹

LOW E1

FULL-FRAME REPLACEMENT

INSERT REPLACEMENT

If your current window frames are in good condition and you want to maintain the size and style, this may be the right option for you. New windows are inserted directly into your existing frame for a more efficient, less disruptive installation. This method can minimize labor costs without compromising performance.

FULL-FRAME REPLACEMENT For replacement windows, this approach is typically used if you want to completely transform your home with a new size or style. Your consultant may also recommend this method if water or structural damage are a concern. While a full-frame replacement has less impact on your exteriors than a new build, it does require removal and replacement of trim. All Infinity doors are installed with full-frame replacement.
